Summer Schedule

The Church Council, all those in church elected leadership positions, met and discussed the summer schedule. We are trying to make the schedule a little different and offer some opportunities for fellowship away from the building. We also want to encourage attendance in the midst of the heat and humidity.

Beginning the first of June, we will discontinue Wednesday evening programming until September. Committees will meet on Wednesdays. Circle the 2nd Wednesday of each month. We will meet at a local park for food and fellowship. You are encouraged to bring food from home or stop and pick something up. Each family is responsible for their own food (not covered dish) - you eat what you bring. If you would like to bring a game to play, a ball to throw or some other fun activity, please do. In June, we will meet at Dorey Park. In July, we will meet at Three Lakes Park. In August, we will meet at Osborne Landing. You are asked to bring a lawn chair or a blanket. If we can move our hearing devices to be used in the gym, then we will probably move worship to the gym in July and August so that we don't have to cool the whole Sanctuary. We will let you know about that as we get closer to July.
