A NOTE FROM OUR PASTOR

The 21st Century Carlisle Team made its initial report concerning a major revision to our organizational structure at our Quarterly Business Meeting on Jan. 16. The changes that are being recommended are not just to make changes. The team that worked on the update did so because we are working from a document designed for churches in the 1950 and 1960's. That design worked well in that period, but it is not working so well for us today. Change just to change is not a good thing. Change to improve the way we make decisions and to respond to needs in our world today can be a good thing.

Our current structure followed the business model that was prevalent in the mid 20th Century. Granted it is one many of us grew up with and therefore we are very comfortable with, but we are finding that that structure does not work well in the 21st Century. As I said at our Business Meeting, the BGAV (Virginia Baptists) have recently gone through a restructuring. They saw the need to become more nimble and be better equipped to make decisions faster, with less hoops. It has taken a couple of years to learn and navigate the new structure, but it is working. I expect we will have some of the same pains as we adapt, if we approve the new structure. In the end though, I believe we will have a less cumbersome structure and that people will be serving where their gifts and passions are.

There will be opportunities in February and March for you to come and ask questions and share your concerns about what is being proposed. The 21st Century team will work hard to provide times that meet the needs of those who want to learn more. These sessions will also be opportunities for the team to explain their rationale for the new structure and how they believe it will help the church to function more effectively. Be looking for announcements about those sessions and come take part in the dialogue.

Families are asked to transport themselves to and from the museum. Parents are encouraged to attend the museum with their children. Ticket prices for a group of 10 people are: Adults - \$8 (10 or more \$2.00 off regular price), Ages 13 - college - \$6, Ages 65 & up - \$6, Ages 12 & under - \$4.

2018 Year End Report for Eastern Henrico FISH:

Direct Financial Assistance (utilities, medicine, etc.) to 146 households (203 Adults, 125 Children) = \$30,351

In-kind Support (food, clothing, school supplies, etc.) to 167 households (238 Adults, 195 Children) = \$50,950 value + nearly 3000 volunteer hrs.

Our church supports this ministry partner by giving the benevolent funds collected at the exit doors of the sanctuary every 1st Sunday, by collecting items monthly to stock the food and clothes closets and participating in the monthly fund-raisers. In September we hosted the rock 'n' roll Diner/Dance in our gym that netted over \$1000. Maristela Araujo is our representative on the FISH Board of Directors. Additional volunteers are needed. FISH operations are housed at the Village Presbyterian Church on Laburnum Avenue.
